

Crisis Mobile


Crisis mobile provides short-term crisis response, crisis intervention, and stabilization for adults and children experiencing a mental health or substance use crisis in the community. The goal of these services are engagement, symptom reduction, and stabilization, assessing the immediate crisis and facilitating resolution and de-escalation. 24/7 crisis response team is deployed by law enforcement, MCMHA access, and MCMHA after hours.
