

Respite offers support to maintain living in the family home, relief from daily stress, and care demands during times of unpaid care. This service is provided on a shortterm, intermittent basis.

What is expected of me?

· Report any concerns or areas of need

• Utilize this time for caregiver relief and self-care

• Spend time with friends or other family members

· MCMHA staff will complete respite assessment

What to expect from Respite?

• MCMHA staff will send referrals to external qualified providers to search for staff and/or link you with a Self-Directed Service Agreement

- Monroe County residents
- · Meets medical necessity for service
- · Child lives with parent/guardian
