What to expect from Wraparound Services?

- Weekly to bi-weekly visits in your home, community, or office
- · Help to identify family strengths and mission, set goals, determine needs, and develop strategies to meet those needs
- Help to create a plan that includes ways to ensure children and families can experience successes
- · Help to form support systems and facilitate team meetings to discuss progress and move towards common goal
- · Supportive, encouraging, knowledge staff

Who is eligible?

- Monroe County resident's eligible for CMH services
- Individuals who meet 2 of the 5 criteria:
 - Involved in multiple child/youth serving systems
 - At-risk of out of home placement or are currently in an out-of-home placement
 - Served through other mental health services with minimal improvement
 - Risk factors exceed capacity for traditional community-based options
 - Identified outcomes are not being met by current provider
