What is expected of me?

- Answer questions as honestly and completely as you can

What to expect from Youth Diversion?

- Age-appropriate screenings
- Coordination of family and youth to services and supports
- Team with juvenile justice partners to promote and identify diversion opportunities

Who is eligible?

- Youth aged 0-18
- At risk for or have pre-existing mental health and/or substance use disorder
- At risk for juvenile justice involvement or has come to the attention of the juvenile justice system and pre-adjudicated youth
- Services are available at no cost to the youth, family or referral sources, regardless of insurance type
