

As of October 1, 2023, MCMHA is a Certified Community Behavioral Health Clinic (CCBHC), allowing us to serve Veterans in our community!

CCBHCs are responsible for intensive, community-based behavioral health care for certain members of the U.S. Armed Forces and Veterans, particularly those armed forces members located 50 miles or more from a Military Treatment Facility (MTF) and Veterans living 40 miles or more from a VA medical facility.

What is expected of me?

· Actively participate in services

What can I expect?

- Help linking to the Veterans Health Administration (VHA) Services; Veterans who decline or who are ineligible for VHA services can be served by MCMHA.
- Integration and coordination of substance use disorders, physical health, and behavioral health services
- Assignment of Principal Behavioral Health Provider who is responsible for linking and coordinating treatment, developing a person-centered, recovery-oriented treatment plan, and connecting with a psychiatrist (if appropriate)
- · Access to peers and veteran navigators

Who is eligible?

- Any current or former military service member with a mental health or substance abuse diagnosis, regardless of insurance
- Anyone experiencing a crisis
