What to expect from a CCBHC?

- Crisis mental health services
- · Screening, assessment, and diagnosis, including risk assessment
- Patient-centered treatment planning including risk assessment and crisis planning
- · Outpatient mental health and substance use services
- Outpatient clinic primary care screening and monitoring of key health indicators and risk
- Targeted case management
- Psychiatric rehabilitation services
- · Peer support and counselor services and family supports
- Intensive, community-based mental health care for members of the armed forces & Veterans

Who is eligible?

- Anyone with a mental health or substance abuse diagnosis, regardless of insurance
- · Anyone experiencing a crisis
